And The Defense Wins Published 12-13-17 by DRI

William Kronenberg



On November 7, 2017, a jury in Kern County, California, returned a defense verdict in a products liability trial for DRI member <u>William Kronenberg</u>, on behalf of Barbar Inc., a Beverley Hills supplier of beauty and hair products. The plaintiff, owner of a Bakersfield beauty salon, sustained a serious eye injury while assembling a hair steamer manufactured in China and distributed by Barbar, Inc. She underwent four surgical procedures, including implantation of an artificial lens, trabeculectomy and revision surgeries. At

trial, plaintiff submitted a \$1.8 million dollar future life care plan, and asked the jury to award a total of \$5 million dollars in past and future damages. Strict product liability theories, including design defect under both the consumer expectations and risk-benefits tests, as well as failure to warn, were presented to the jury and rejected outright, resulting in a complete defense verdict.
